Galvanising is the process of applying a protective zinc coating to steel or iron, to prevent rusting. The process produces a coating which is bonded metallurgically to steel to iron. The most in which parts are submerged in a bath of molten zinc. The thickness of the galvanised coating is determined principally by the thickness of the steel. This is the standard finish to most of our steel products.
